



ORIGINAL GARMENT: One size fits all.

MATERIALS:

9 Balls **HARMONY** 50g
Colour - 2114

6mm Knitting needles
2 Buttons

MEASUREMENTS:

60cm wide, +/- 140cm long.

TENSION:

14sts = 10cm over pattern using 6mm
knitting needles.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt – alternate
beg – begin(ing)
cont – continue
GS – garter stitch
k – knit
k2tog – knit 2sts together
p – purl
patt – pattern
skpso – slip one st, knit 1st, pass slip st over
the knit st
sl – slip
st(s) – stitch(es)
yf – yarn to the front of needle as if to purl
R(W)SF – right (wrong) side facing
WSR – wrong side row

STITCHES USED:

Pattern:

1st, 3rd & 5th row: K9 *(yf, k2tog)* to last 9sts,
k9.

All alt rows: K8, p to last 8sts k to end.

7th, 9th & 11th rows: K9 *(skpso, yf)* to last
9sts, k9.

Garter stitch:

K every st and row.

NOTE:

Sl the first st of every row to keep the
edge neat. Join the new ball in the GS
border not at beg of a new row.

PATTERN:

Cast on 84sts. With the WSR, work in GS for
11rows. Work in patt for 85cm.
Work 1st button hole at beg of a WSR.

1st Row: 3sts cast off 3sts, patt to end.

2nd Row: Work to 3 cast off sts. Turn work
and cast on 3sts. Turn work, k3.

Work a 2nd buttonhole 8rows after the first.
Cont in patt until work measures +/-140cm
from the beg, end with a WSR. Work
11rows GS, cast off.

Sew on buttons and weave in all loose
threads.
