CUSHION AND THROW

IMPORTANT NOTE: Unless yarn specified is used, African Expressions cannot accept the responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

Original articles worked in one size only.

MATERIALS: COMFORT (50g balls)

THROW AND CUSHION COVER:

16 balls 4024 Orange A, 3 balls 4008 Olive B and 7 balls 4004 Cream C.

One pair 5,5mm knitting needle.

MEASUREMENTS:

Throw: 122cm x 200cm.

Cushion cover: 50cm x 50cm.

THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE ONE SIZE ONLY.

TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

16sts and 20 rows = 10cm over stocking stitch using an 5,5mm knitting needles.

FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.

IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;

IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg = begin(ning); **cont** = continue; **g st** = garter stitch; **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern(s); **p** = purl; **rep** = repeat; **R(W)S** = right(wrong) side; **R(W)SF** = right(wrong) side facing; **R(W)SR** = right(wrong) side row; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **st st** = stocking stitch.

STITCHES USED:

GARTER STITCH:

K every row.

STOCKING STITCH:

1st row: RSF, one row K.

2nd row: WSF, one row P.

Rep these 2 rows.

THROW:

Using 5,5mm needles cast and A, cast on (using thumb method) 118sts A, 12sts B and 66sts C = 196sts. Work in g st for 5cm as colours appear ending with a WSR. Now work in g st and st st as follows: **Next row:** K, working colours as they appear. **Next row:** K8sts A, p110sts A, p12sts B, p58sts C, k8sts C. Rep last 2 rows and until work measures 132cm from beg ending with a

WSR. Working in g st and st st as before, change to B only and work this stripe for 8cm ending with a WSR. Change to A and work as follows: K118sts A, k12sts B, k66sts C. **Next row:** K8sts C, p58sts C, p8sts B, p110sts A, k8sts A. Rep last 2 rows until work measures 195cm from beg ending with a WSR. Cont in colours as they appear, work in g st only for 5cm ending with a WSR, cast off all sts.

TO MAKE UP:

Block throw to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.

CUSHION COVER

FRONT:

Using 5,5mm needles, cast on (using thumb method) 46sts A, 8sts B, then 26sts C. Cont straight in st st until work measures 26cm from beg ending with a WSR. Change to B only and work this stripe for 8cm ending with a WSR. Change to A and work as follows: K46sts A, k8sts B, k26sts C. Cont in colours as they appear and when work measures 50cm from beg ending with a WSR, cast off all sts.

BACK (With buttonholes):

Using 5,5mm needles and A, cast on 80sts and cont straight in st st until work measures 30cm from beg ending with a WSR. **Next row, buttonhole row:** RSF, k14sts, cast off 4sts, *k12sts, cast off 4sts, rep from * twice more, k14sts (= 4 buttonholes). **Next row:** P, casting on 4sts over each buttonhole. Now cont straight in g st and when work measures 35cm from beg ending with a WSR, cast off all sts.

BACK (Without buttonholes):

Work as for back with buttonholes, omitting buttonholes.

TO MAKE UP:

RSF, lay front piece down. RS to inside, lay buttonhole panel of back down and pin to cast on edge. Lay other back on top of that to cast off edge (overlapping middle). Sew all around. Turn inside out. Sew buttons into place. Block cushion cover to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
