



ORIGINAL GARMENT: One Size Fits All

MATERIALS:

5 balls **CURIOSITY** 50g in colour 9057
5.5mm knitting needles
2 stitch markers

TENSION:

Not required

ABBREVIATIONS:

k – knit
p – purl
st(s) – stitch(es)
rem – remaining
wsf – wrong side facing
rsf – right side facing
cont – continue

STITCH PATTERNS:

STOCKING STITCH:

Row 1: Knit all sts

Row 2: Purl all sts

CARDIGAN:

Using 5.5mm knitting needles, cast on 133sts. Cont in Stocking Stitch until work measures 50cm. With RSF, knit 67sts as normal, cast off loosely 43sts, knit rem 23sts as normal. With WSF, purl 23sts sts, cast on 43sts, purl rem 67sts to end. You have now created the first arm hole.

Cont straight in stocking stitch until work measure 100cm from cast on edge, or to desired width between armholes. With RSF, knit 67sts as normal, cast off loosely 43sts, knit rem 23sts as normal. With WSF, purl 23sts sts, cast on 43sts, purl rem 67sts to end. You have now created the second armhole.

Cont straight in stocking stitch until work measures 50cm from second armhole. Cast off all 133sts loosely.

Work in all loose ends. Cardigan is now complete.
