

# AE - 12003 **CROCHET TOP**

# ORIGINAL GARMENT: 91-97cm

To Fit Bust:	81-87cm	91-97cm	102-107cm	111-117cm
Actual all round measurements of garment:	90cm	100cm	110cm	120cm
Length to Shoulder:	62cm	62cm	62cm	62cm
Sleeve Seam:	40cm	40cm	40cm	40cm

## MATERIALS.

5(5,5,6) balls **CURIOSITY** 50g in colour 9081 - Main colour

2(2,2,2) balls **CURIOSITY** 50g in colour 9223

– Contrast colour

4mm Crochet hook

# TENSION:

15 tr to 10 cm using 4 mm hook

# **ABBREVIATION:**

alt - alternate

beg - begin

**ch** - chain

dc - double crochet

**dec** - decrease rep - repeat;

R(W)S - right(wrong) side

tr - treble

tch - turning chain

MS - Main Shade

C - Contrast Shade

yo - yarn over

patt - pattern

# STITCHES USED:

V STITCH:

2 treble into the space between 2 treble

# TREBLE 2 TOG: (tr2tg)

Yo, insert hook in next st/yo, insert hook in next st, yo pull through all loops on hook (1st decrease)

\*\* With MS make 73 (81;87;97) ch Row 1: 1tr into 4th ch from hook, 1tr into each ch to end of row. 70(78;84;94)tr **Row 2:** 3ch, 1tr into the space between 1st and next tr \* miss 2tr, 2tr (one V) into next space. Rep from \* to last 3tr, miss 2tr, 1V in tch.

Row 2 sets the patt.

Rows 3 & 4: Work as for row 2, turn.

**Rows 5 & 6:** C, as row 2, turn.

Rows 7 & 8: MS, as row 2, turn.

Rows 9 to 16: Rep rows 5 to 8 twice more

Rows 17 & 18: As row 5 & 6.

Rows 19 to 26: MS, As row 2.

Row 27: C, as row 2 - DO NOT TURN

Row 28: Return to the beg of row, join MS, make 3ch and patt to end, turn.

Rows 29 to 32: As given for rows 27 & 28.

Rows 33 to 40: MS. As row 2.

Rows 41 to 46: Rep. rows 27 to 32\*\*. Continue in MS only until back measures

62cm from starting ch. Fasten off.

Work as given for back from \*\* to \*\* Continue in MS until front is 12 rows less than back to shoulder line ending with a

# SHAPE NECK:

**Row 1:** Work across 13(15;16;18) patt, turn.

**Row 2:** Tr2tog, patt to end.

Row 3: Patt to end.

Rep rows 2 & 3 until 10(12;12;14) patt. Work straight until front matches back to shoulder line. Fasten off.

With RS facing return to unworked sts and miss 9(9;10;11) centre patt, join yarn into next V and complete to match first side.

# **SLEEVES:** (both alike)

With MS make 45(45;53;53)ch and work rows 1 and 2 of patt as given for Back. Rep row 2, twice more.

Next 2 rows: C, patt to end. Next 2 rows: MS, patt to end. Rep first 2 rows once more.

Continue in MS and shape side as follows: Row 1: 3ch, 2tr in first space, \* miss 2tr, 2tr in next space. Rep from \* ending with 2tr in last space.

# Rows 2 to 4: Patt to end.

Rep last 4 rows 6(6;7;7) times more and cont in MS until sleeve measures 40cm from starting ch. Fasten off.

# TO MAKE UP:

Join shoulder seams.

# **NECK BORDER:**

With RS facing and MS, join yarn to neck edge of left shoulder seam and work 32(32;34;36)tr along front neck edge and 24(24;26;28) tr around back neck edge, Join round with a slip st.

Round 1: C, work 2tr between next tr to end of round, close round with a slip st.

Round 2: MS, as round 1. Round 3: C, as round 1.

Fasten off.

Mark points along the side edges, 20(20;22;22)cm either side of shoulder seam and sew sleeve between markers. Join side and sleeve seam. Block garment to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
