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AE - 10001 LACEY RIB PULLOVER

ORIGINAL GARMENT: 87cm.

To Fit Bust	82cm	87cm	92cm	97cm	102cm	107cm	112cm
Measurement all Round	100cm	105cm	110cm	115cm	120cm	125cm	130cm
Shoulder Length	70cm	72cm	72cm	72cm	74cm	74cm	76cm
Sleeve Seam	43cm	45cm	46cm	47cm	48cm	48cm	49cm

MATERIALS:

5(6,6,7,7,8,8) Hanks **EXPRESS YOURSELF DESIRE** 100g

Colour - Ecru

5.5mm Knitting needle 6mm Knitting needle Stitch holder Stitch markers

TENSION:

15sts x 20 rows = 10cm over Faggotted Rib patt using 6mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt - alternate

beg - begin(ning)

cont - continue

STITCHES USED:

Double rib pattern:

1st Row: *K2, p2, rep from * to last 2sts, k2. 2nd Row: *P2, k2, rep from * to last 2sts, p2. Rep these 2 rows.

Faggotted rib pattern:

(Worked over a multiple of 4sts + 2sts)

1st Row: K3,*yfd, SKPO, k2, rep from * to last 3sts, yfd, SKPO, k1.

2nd Row: P3, *yrn, p2tog, p2, rep from * to last 3sts, yrn, p2tog, p1. Rep these 2 rows.

PATTERN:

BACK:

Using 5.5mm ns cast on 74(78,82,86,90,94) sts and work in **double**

rib patt for 6(6,7,7,7,7,7)cm end with a RSR.

Change to 6mm ns and cont straight in **faggotted Rib patt** until work measures 70(72,72,72,74,74,76)cm from beg end with a WSR, cast off all sts.

Mark centre 24(26,26,28,28,30,30)sts with a coloured thread for neck opening.

FRONT:

Work as for back and when work measures 60(60,60,60,60,60,62)cm from beg end with a WSR, **SHAPE NECK:** K32(33,35,36,38,39,41)sts and leave these on a stitch holder, cast off centre 10(12,12,14,14,16,16)sts for neck opening and cont on rem sts for the left side of work.

LEFT SIDE:Work one row.

Cast off 2sts at beg (neck edge) of next and foll 2 alt rows, then dec 1st (= work 2tog) at same edge foll alt row = 25(26,28,29,31,32,34)sts.

Cont straight and when work measures 70(72,72,74,74,76)cm from beg end a WSR, cast off all sts.

RIGHT SIDE: WSF, rejoin yarn at neck edge, pick up sts from holder and work as for left side, rev shaping.

SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE):

Using 5.5mm ns cast on 34(38,38,42,42,42,42)sts and work in **double rib patt** for 6(6,7,7,7,7,7)cm end with a WSR.

Change to 6mm ns and work in **faggotted rib patt**, inc 1st at each end of every foll 4^{th} row 0(0,0,0,0,0,2) times, every foll 6^{th} row 9(3,11,10,9,13,12) times, then every foll 8^{th} row 2(7,1,2,3,0,0) times

= 56(58,62,66,66,68,70)sts.

Cont straight and when work measures

43(45,46,47,48,49)cm from beg end with a WSR, cast off all sts.

TO MAKE UP:

Sew right should seam.

NECKBAND: RSF, using 5.5mm ns, pick up and k50(60,60,62,62,64,64)sts around neck opening of front and 24(26,26,28,28,30)sts across back neck = 74(86,86,90,92,94,94)sts. Work in **double rib patt**, beg with k2, for 2cm end with a WSR. Cast off all sts RW.

Sew left shoulder seam and neckband ends. Place marker 24(25,26,27,28,29) cm on either side of shoulder seams. Set in sleeves between markers. Sew up side and sleeve seams. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.





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
