


AE - 10004 CROCHET | FREE PATTERN





ORIGINAL GARMENT: 6 - 7 years.

MATERIALS:

3(4,5) Hank EXPRESS YOURSELF DESIRE 100g

Colour - Ecru

4.5mm Crochet hook Stitch markers

Measurements:

Sizes: 4 - 5 years(6 - 7 years, 8 - 9 years) To fit actual chest: 58(64,67)cm All round measurements: Chest: 64(68,72)cm Length to shoulder: 36(40,44)cm Sleeve length: 33(35,36)cm

TENSION:

12sts x 7rows = 10x10cm working with a 4.5mm crochet hook and in htr's.

ABBREVIATIONS:

2trtog - two treble together, beg begin(ing), ch - chain, chsp(s) - chain, space(s), cont - continue, htr - half treble, patt - pattern, rep - repeat, rev - reverse, rnd(s) - round(s), RS - right side, sk - skip, sl st - slip stitch, st - stitch, tr - treble, WS - wrong side

NOTES:

The pullover is designed to be a fairly loose fit, with easily adjustable body and sleeve lengths.

Start each tr row with $ch3 (= 1^{st} st)$. Start each dc/htr row with a ch1. This does not count as a stitch.

PATTERN:

BACK:

With 4.5mm crochet hook, loosely make 40(46,52)ch.

1st Row: (RS), Insert hook in the 4th ch from the hook and make 1dc, *sk 2 ch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next ch, sk 2 ch, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in next ch*, rep from * to last 6 ch, sk 2ch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next ch, sk 2ch, (1dc, ch1, 1htr) in last ch, turn.

2nd Row: Ch3, 2tr at the base of the ch3, *(1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp*, rep from the * to last 2chsp, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the last 2chsp, 3tr in the last st, turn.

3rd Row: Ch1, (1htr, ch1, 1dc) at the base of the ch1, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp*, rep from * across to the last 3chsp, (2tr, ch1, 2tr) in the last 3chsp, (1dc, ch1, 1htr) in the last st, turn.

Rep 2nd - 3rd row until piece measures 36(40,44)cm, NOTE end with 2nd row of the st patt. Fasten off.

FRONT:

Work as for back, but when work is 4 rows shorter than the back, shape neckline: LEFT FRONT:

Next row: Ch1, (1htr, ch1, 1dc) at the base of the ch1, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp*, rep from * a total of 2(2,3)times, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next 3chsp, 1dc in next 2chsp, turn. Next row: SI st to the 2chsp, ch1, 1dc in the 2chsp, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp*, rep from * a total of 2(2,3)times, 3tr in the last st. turn.

Next row: Ch1, (1htr, ch1, 1dc) at the base of the ch1, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp* rep from * a total of 1(1,2)times, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next 3chsp, 1dc in next 2chsp, 1dc in next 2 tr, turn.

Next row: SI st over first dc, 1htr in next 2dc, *(1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp* rep from a total of 1(1,2)times, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp, 3tr in the last st. Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT:

Rep as for left front, rev all shapings.

SLEEVES: (make 2)

With 4.5mm crochet hook, loosely make 27(31,35)ch.

1st Row: (RS), Insert hook in the 4th ch from hook and make 1tr, 1tr in next 3(5,7)ch, *sk next 2ch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next ch, sk 2ch, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next ch*, rep from * a total of 2 times, sk next 2ch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next ch, sk next 2ch, 1tr in the last 4(6,8)ch, turn.

2nd Row: Ch3, 1tr in the next 3(5,7)tr, *(1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp*, rep from * a total of 2 times, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp, 1tr in the next 4(6,8)tr, turn.

3rd Row: Ch3, 1tr in the next 3(5,7)tr, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the next 2chsp*, rep from * a total of 2 times, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next 3chsp, 1tr in the next 4(6,8)tr, turn.

Rep 2nd - 3rd row; AT THE SAME TIME inc 1 st at the beg and end on the 7th row and thereafter every 4th row, a total of 5 times. Next rows: Cont straight until piece measures 33(35,36) cm or desired length.

Fasten off.

FINISH UP:

With RS facing, join the shoulders. Fold the sleeves in half lengthways. Place the midway point on the shoulder seam, RS facing, pin in place and sew together.

With RS facing, pin the sleeve and side seams and sew together.

EDGING:

Join yarn anywhere around the neckline, using a 4.5mm crochet hook. Work 1 rnd of evenly spaced (1dc in the next 2 sts, ch3, close with sl st in 1st ch) around the neckline. Don't sk any sts, or leave gaps between the dc's. Close the rnd with a sl st. Rep around the bottom edge and the sleeves.

Weave in all rem loose ends. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth (or spray with water) and allow to dry.
