AE - 5013 MENS PULLOVER

ORIGINAL GARMENT: 107cm.

| To Fit Chest | 87cm | 92cm | 97cm | 102cm | 107cm | 112cm |
|---------------------|-------|-------|-------|-------|-------|-------|
| Actual Size: Length | 102cm | 107cm | 112cm | 117cm | 122cm | 127cm |
| Length from Top | 64cm | 66cm | 68cm | 70cm | 70cm | 72cm |
| Sleeve seam: | 45cm | 46cm | 47cm | 48cm | 49cm | 49cm |

MATERIALS:

19(20,21,22,23,24) Balls **FREEDOM** 50g Colour - 5072

3.25mm Knitting needles 4mm Knitting needles Row counter

TENSION:

22 stitches x 30 rows = 10cm over stocking stitch using 4mm knitting needles.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt - alternate beg - begin(ning) cont - continue inc - increase k - knit K1B - knit one below = (work into next st below it) n(s) - needle(s) p - purl patt - pattern rep - repeat R(W)SF - right (wrong) side facing st(s) - stitch(es) st st - stocking stitch

STITCHES USED:

Double rib (worked over 4sts + 2): 1st Row: K2*p2, k2 to end. 2nd Row: P2*k2, p2 to end. Rep these 2 rows.

Rib below (multiple of 10sts):

1st Row: (WS), k. 2nd Row: *(K1B, p1) twice, K1B, k5. Rep these 2 rows for patt.

Stocking stitch (st st):

1st Row: (RS), k. **2nd Row:** (WS), p. Rep these 2 rows.

PATTERN: BACK:

With 3.25mm ns cast on 118 (122,130,134,142,146)sts and work in **double rib patt** for 7cm end with a RSF row.

Next Row: Rib to end dec 2(2,4,2,6,2)sts evenly across row 116(120,126,132,136,

144)sts.

Change to 4mm ns and work in patt as follows:

1st - 25th Row: St st.

26th Row: K. **27th Row:** K3(5,3,6,3,7)sts work 2nd row of **rib below patt** from * to *11(11,12,12,13,13)

Rep 26th & 27th rows, 7 times then row 26 once. Rep patt from 1st - 40th row, 4 times then

from $1^{st} - 25^{th}$ row once.

Rep 26th & 27th row of patt until back measures 62(64,66,68,68,70)cm from cast on edge end with a WSF. Work 2cm in k2, p2 rib and cast off loosely.

FRONT:

Work as given for back.

SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE):

With 3.25mm ns cast on 58(58,62,62,66,70) sts and work in **double rib patt** for 5cm end with a WSF.

Change to 4mm ns and work in patt as given for back.

To shape sides inc st at each end of every foll 8(6,6,6,6,6)rows 12(9,7,7,7,7)times, then on every 8th row until 88(92,96,96,100,100) sts taking inc sts into patt. When sleeve measures 45(46,47,48,49,49)cm end WSF. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP:

Sew shoulder seams leaving opening for neck about 40cm. Set in sleeve. Sew side and sleeve seams. Block garment to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.



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
