To Fit:	87cm	92cm	97cm	102cm	107cm
Actual All Round Measurement:	92cm	97cm	102cm	107cm	112cm
Length from Top:	54cm (Front) & 72cm (Back)				
Sleeve Seam:	43cm	43cm	44cm	45cm	46cm

MATERIALS:

9(10;11;12;14) balls **FREEDOM** 50g in colour 5277 – Main colour
5(6;6;7;7) balls **FREEDOM** 50g in colour 5019 – Contrast colour
4.5mm crochet hook

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch – chain
tr - treble
dc - double crochet
sp(s) - space(s)
sls - slip stitch
tch - turning chain
rep - repeat
patt - pattern
MS – Main Shade
C - Contrast

TENSION:

15 Treble to 10cm using 4.5mm crochet hook

STITCHES USED:

CROSSHATCH STITCH: Multiple of 7+4
(Add 3 ch for starting chain)

Row 1: (Foundation row) 2 tr in 4th ch from hook, * miss 3 ch, 1 dc in next ch, 3ch, 1 tr into each of next 3 ch, Rep from * to last 4 ch, miss 3 ch, 1 dc in last ch. Turn.

Row 2: 3ch (counts as 1 tr) 2 tr in first dc, *miss 2 tr, 1 dc in next tr, 3 ch, 3 tr in next chsp. Rep from * to last 3 tr, miss 2 tr, 1 dc in last tr.

2nd row sets the pattern.

STRIPE SEQUENCE:

Body: 6 rows MS, 2 rows C

Sleeves and Yoke: 2 rows MS, 2 rows C.

BACK:

Using MS and 4.5mm crochet hook make 130(144;158;172;186) ch and work in patt as given (see Stitches used) 18(20;22;24;26) patt. Alternate colours by working 6 rows MS and 2 rows C, 6 times. Break off C.

SHAPE FOR SLEEVES:

Using MS make 116(116;123;123;130) ch and join with a sls in last dc of previous row and continue across 18(20;22;24;26) patt from back. At the end of row

make 112(112;126;126;133) ch, Turn. Work across the ch as given for 1st row of patt. 16(16;17;17;18) repeats. Work across sts from back and continue as given for 1st row of patt across the 2nd ch. 16(16;17;17;18) repeats.

Cont in patt alternating 2 rows in MS and 2 rows in C, 3(3;4;4;4) times. Work one more row in MS.

Last Row: (RS) ;3ch, 1 tr at the base of ch, *miss 1 tr, 1 dc in each of next 2 tr, 1 dc in 3 chsp, 2 tr in next dc * Rep from * to * ending with 1 tr in tch***

FRONT:

Work as given for Back from ** to ** alternating the 2 colours 4 time then continue from *** to *** as given for back.

TO MAKE UP:

Join shoulder seams leaving open for neck about 30(30;35;35;35) cm.

Join underarm and side seams to match patt.



CUFF EDGING:

With RS facing and MS using 4.5mm hook join yarn at the base of underarm seam and make 1 round dc around cuff edge. SlS to first dc.

Next round: *3ch and 2 tr in the same dc, miss 2 dc , 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end of round. Close with a sls in first dc .

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
