

## HARMONY

#### Harmony Bobble Button Cowl

IMPORTANT NOTE: Unless yarn specified is used, African Expressions cannot accept the responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

Original garment worked in one size only.

#### **MATERIALS:**

Harmony (50g balls) 7 balls Col.2044 One pair 6.5mm knitting needles One pair 3mm knitting needles One 4.5mm crochet hook Toy stuffing

### MEASUREMENTS:

Approx. 30cm wide, 135cm long THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE SMALLEST SIZE, WITH THE LARGER SIZES IN BRACKETS; WHERE ONLY ONE FIGURE IS GIVEN, IT APPLIES TO ALL SIZES.

TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION 14.5sts and 29 10cm rows = over pattern stitch using 6.5mm needles. FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION. IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES; IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

k = knit; K1B = Knit one below, knit through next
stitch one row below and at same time slip stitch
above off needle; inc = increase; P2tog = Purl 2
stitches together; st(s) = stitch(es); R(W)SR = right
(wrong) side row; cont - continue; patt = Pattern;
rep = repeat; R(W)SF = Right (wrong) side facing;
DC = Double crochet; ch = chain; revstst = reverse
stocking stitch.

#### STITCHES USED:

REVERSE STOCKING STITCH:

1st Row: Purl 2nd Row: Knit GARTER STITCH: Every row knit

HONEYCOMB BRIOCHE: Multiple of 2 sts

1st Row: (RSR) Knit

2nd Row: \*K1, K1B\* rep to last 2 sts, K2

3rd Row: Knit

4th Row: K2, \*K1B, K1\* rep to end

#### COWL:

Using 6.5mm needles, cast on 44 sts. Rep rows 1-4 until work measures 130cm ending with RSR. Work 4 rows Garter stitch. Cast off loosely.

#### **BOBBLE BUTTONS:**

Using 3mm needles cast on 10sts (RSF), purl.

**Next row:** K inc in each st = 20sts.

Starting with a P row, work 10 rows in rev st st.

**Next row:** P2tog to end = 10sts. Thread through rem sts. Leave 15cm thread, gather cast on edge draw up tightly, secure. Sew side edges together. Stuff with toy stuffing, not too tight. Draw thread through sts tightly, secure. Pass this thread through centre of bobble to cast on sts use this thread for sewing bobble to edge of cowl as shown in photo (cast off edge)

Cast on edge: Using crochet hook, work 42dc along cast on edge. Turn, 1 ch, 1dc in next 2dc. \*7ch miss next 6 dc, dc in next 2dc rep from \* 4 times more. Fasten off.

#### TO MAKE UP:

Block cowl to measurement, cover with damp cloth and allow to dry.



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
