



ORIGINAL GARMENT: 82cm.

### MATERIALS:

2 balls each **HOPE** 25g  
Colour - 6003 (CA), 6283 (CB), 6280 (CC),  
6057(CD), 6071(CE), 6258 (CF), 6039 (CG)

4mm Crochet hook

### TENSION:

16tr x 9 rows = 10 x 10cm.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**C(?)** - colour (letter), **ch** - chain, **chsp** - chain space, **dc** - double crochet, **htr** - half treble, **L(F)S** - left (front) side, **rev** - reverse, **R(F)S** - right (front) side, **RSF** - right side facing, **sk** - skip, **st(s)** - stitch(es), **tr** - treble

### PATTERN NOTES:

The coat is worked in one piece (right and left front and back) up to the armholes where it is then split between the front and back pieces. The sleeves are worked separately.

When working rows in dc, start the row with ch1, this doesn't count as a stitch. When working rows in tr, start the row with ch3, the does count as the first st.

### NOTE:

After each row and change of colour turn and fasten off, unless spesified otherwise.

### PATTERN:

With 4mm hook, make 227(251,275)ch.

**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** Using CA, insert hook in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook and make tr, work tr in each ch, turn. (= 225(249,273)sts)

**2<sup>nd</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> Row:** Tr.

**4<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CB, tr.

**9<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CC, dc.

**10<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CD, tr.

**13<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CE, dc.

**14<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CD, tr.

**15<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CE, tr.

**18<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CF, dc.

**19<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CA, tr.

**20<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> Row:** Use CG, tr.

**23<sup>rd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CB, tr.

**25<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CD, tr.

**26<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CA, dc.

**27<sup>th</sup> - 28<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CF, tr.

**29<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CC, dc.

**30<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CF, tr.

**31<sup>st</sup> Row:** Use CC, tr.

**32<sup>nd</sup> - 35<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CG, tr.

**36<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CD, tr.

**37<sup>th</sup> - 39<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CA, tr.

**40<sup>th</sup> - 44<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CE, tr.

**45<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CB, dc.

**46<sup>th</sup> - 47<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CD, tr.

**48<sup>th</sup> - 50<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CC, tr.

**51<sup>st</sup> Row:** Use CA, tr.

**52<sup>nd</sup> - 53<sup>rd</sup> Row:** Use CB, tr.

**54<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CG, tr.

**55<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CA, dc.

**56<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CF, tr.

### BACK:

Sk the first 81(89,97)sts and insert hook into the next st, only work across the next 63(71,79)sts, leaving the last 81(89,97)sts unworked. Proceed with colour changes and sts as follows:

**57<sup>th</sup> - 59<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CE, tr.

**60<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CF, tr.

**61<sup>st</sup> - 63<sup>rd</sup> Row:** Use CA, tr.

**64<sup>th</sup> - 65<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CD, tr.

**66<sup>th</sup> - 68<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CG, tr.

**69<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CC, tr.

**70<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CG, tr

**71<sup>st</sup> - 73<sup>rd</sup> Row:** Use CB, tr.

**74<sup>th</sup> - 75<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CA, tr.

### RIGHT FRONT:

Work across the first 75(83,91)sts only.

The rem 6sts between the RF and the back forms part of the armhole.

**57<sup>th</sup> - 59<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CE, tr.

**60<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CF, tr.

**61<sup>st</sup> - 63<sup>rd</sup> Row:** Use CA, tr.

**64<sup>th</sup> - 65<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CD, tr.

**66<sup>th</sup> - 68<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CG, tr.

**69<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CC, tr.

### NECKLINE SHAPING:

**70<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CG, tr in next 20(25,25)tr, htr in the next 20(20,25)tr, dc in the next 35(38,41) dc.

**71<sup>st</sup> Row:** Use CBdc in the next 35(38,41)dc, htr in the next 20(20,25)htr, tr in the next 20(25,25)tr.

**72<sup>nd</sup> - 73<sup>rd</sup> Row:** Dc in each dc, htr in each htr and tr in each tr.

**74<sup>th</sup> - 75<sup>th</sup> Row:** Use CA, tr in each tr, htr in each htr and dc in each dc. Fasten off.

### LEFT FRONT:

Sk the next 6sts after the first row of the

back and only work across the next 75(83,91)sts. Work exactly as for the right front, but rev all shapings for the neckline. Join the shoulder seams across 20(25,25)sts on both sides.

### SLEEVES (MAKE 2):

With 4mm hook and CG, make 42(42,46)ch.

**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** Insert hook in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook and make tr, work tr in each ch across, turn, (= 40(40,44)sts)

**2<sup>nd</sup> Row onwards:** Tr in each tr across, AT THE SAME TIME inc 1st at the beg and end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> row and every next 3<sup>rd</sup> row (13 times). (=66(66,70)sts)  
The sleeves are worked entirely in tr rows and colour changes are as follows:

**4<sup>th</sup> Row:** CD.

**5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> Row:** CA.

**8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Row:** CE.

**13<sup>th</sup> Row:** CB.

**14<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> Row:** CD.

**16<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> Row:** CC.

**19<sup>th</sup> Row:** CA.

**20<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> Row:** CB.

**22<sup>nd</sup> Row:** CG.

**23<sup>rd</sup> Row:** CA.

**24<sup>th</sup> Row:** CF.

**25<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> Row:** CE.

**28<sup>th</sup> Row:** CF.

**29<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> Row:** CA.

**32<sup>nd</sup> - 33<sup>rd</sup> Row:** CD.

**34<sup>th</sup> - 36<sup>th</sup> Row:** CG.

**37<sup>th</sup> Row:** CC.

**38<sup>th</sup> Row:** CG.

**39<sup>th</sup> - 41<sup>st</sup> Row:** CB.

**42<sup>nd</sup> Row:** CA.

### SHAPE ARMHOLE:

**43<sup>rd</sup> Row:** Sl st over the first 3sts, work across row, leaving last 3sts unworked. Fasten off.

### TO JOIN SLEEVES:

With RSF, join shoulder seams. Fold sleeves in half lengthways, sew sleeves in position. Sew up side and sleeve seams.

### EDGING:

With a 4mm hook and colour CF, with RSF, insert hook in bottom corner. Work 1 row of evenly spaced dc up the RF, around the neckline and down the LF. Fasten off. Weave in all loose ends. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth (or spray with water) and allow to dry.
