THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE SMALLEST SIZE, WITH THE LARGER SIZES IN BRACKETS; WHERE ONLY ONE FIGURE IS GIVEN, IT APPLIES TO ALL SIZES.

## TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

14 sts and 10 rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$ using a $4,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ crochet hook and working in pattern as set.
FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION. IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON THE TEST SWATCH, USE A THINNER CROCHET HOOK; IF THERE ARE TO MANY STS, USE A THICKER CROCHET HOOK.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain; cont = continue; dc = double crochet; dec = decrease; foll(s) = follow(s)ing; rem = remaining; rep = repeat; RS = right side; RSF = right side facing; Sk = skip; sl st = slip stitch; st(s) = stitches; tr $=$ treble; $\mathbf{v}$-st $=2 \operatorname{tr}$ between 2 tr of prev row; $\mathbf{W S}=$ wrong side; WSF = wrong side facing

## PATTERN NOTES:

3ch replace the first tr of every row, 1ch is used to begin rows starting with a dc and does not replace the first dc of each row, unless otherwise stated.

## BACK:

Using a 4.5mm hook and African Expressions Joy, col 1278, ch 70 (78; 86; 94; 102). Foundation row: (WS) 1dc in second ch from hook, 1dc in each ch across, turn $=69(77 ; 85 ; 93 ; 101)$ sts. Next row: Ch1 (does not count as st), 1dc in each dc across. Rep prev row 8 more times. Next row: Ch3 (counts as tr), 1 tr in next dc, *sk next dc, 2 tr in next dc*, rep from *_* to last 3 dc, sk next dc, 1tr in last 2 dc, turn = 68 (76; 84; $92 ; 100) \operatorname{tr}[32(36 ; 40 ; 44 ; 48)$ groups of tr-v stitches, 2 groups of 2 tr at beg and end]. Next row: Ch3 (counts as first tr), 1 tr in next tr, *sk next tr, 2 tr in center of prev v-st*, rep from *-* to last 2 tr , 1tr in last 2 tr , turn.

Rep prev row until piece measures 40 (42; 44; 46; 48)cm.
SHAPE ARMHOLES: (work the same for all sizes)
Next row: SI st over first 6 sts, keep continuity of patt until last 6 sts, turn. Next rows: Dec 1st at beg and end of next 2 rows, turn = $24(28 ; 32 ; 36 ; 40)$ groups of tr-v stitches, 2 groups of 2 tr at beg and end).
Next rows: Cont straight until armholes measures 18 cm .

## SHAPE SHOULDERS:

Next two rows: Keep continuity of pattern and work across next $12(14 ; 16 ; 18 ; 20)$ sts, turn. Work one more row. Rep for second shoulder.

## FRONT:

Work as for back until piece measures $33(35 ; 37 ; 39 ; 41) \mathrm{cm}$.

## SHAPE NECK (Right Front):

Next row: Keep continuity of pattern and work across next $34(38 ; 42 ; 46 ; 50)$ sts, turn. Next 6 rows: Dec one stitch at neckline.

## SHAPE ARMHOLES:

Keep continuity of pattern and shape armholes as for back AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st at neckline every alt row until 12 (14; 16; 18; 20) sts rem. Work straight until armhole measures same as for back. Fasten off. Rep for left front, reversing all shapings. With wrong sides facing, join shoulder and side seams. Weave in all loose ends.

## NECK \& ARMHOLE EDGE:

Using a 4.00 mm hook and with RS facing, work 1 row of evenly spaced dc around the edge. (Approx 2dc per 1 tr). Close with sl st and turn. Work 1 row of htr. Fasten off and weave in all loose ends.

## TO FINISH:

Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth or spray with water and allow to dry.
