AE - 1015 CLASSIC FOR MEN

ORIGINAL GARMENT: 107cm.

To Fit Bust	97cm	102cm	107cm	112cm	117cm	122cm	127cm
Measurement : Chest	110cm	115cm	120cm	125cm	130cm	135cm	140cm
Length to Back of Neck	71cm	73cm	75cm	77cm	79cm	79cm	79cm
Sleeve Seam	46cm	47cm	47cm	47cm	48cm	48cm	49cm

MATERIALS:

15(16,17,18,19,20,21) Balls **JOY** 50g Colour - 1062

3.25 Knitting needles 4mm Knitting needles Stitch holder

TENSION:

22sts x 30 rows = 10cm over stocking stitch using 4mm knitting needles.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt - alternate **beg** - begin(ning) cont - continue dec - decrease foll(s) - follow(s)ing **inc(s)** - increase(s) k - knit n(s) - needle(s) patt(s) - pattern(s) p - purl **rem -** remain(ning) rep - repeat rev - reverse R(W)S - right(wrong)side R(W)SF - right(wrong) side facing R(W)SR - right(wrong) side row **RW** - ribwise st(s) - stitch(es) st st - stocking stitch skpo - slip one, knit one, pass slipped stitch over tbl - through back of loop tog - together

STITCHES USED:

Single rib pattern: 1st Row: K1, *p1, k1, rep from * to end. 2nd Row: P1, *k1, p1, rep from * to end. Rep these 2 rows.

Stocking stitch:

1st Row: RSF, k. 2nd Row: WSF, p. Rep these 2 rows.

PATTERN:

BACK: Using 3.25 ns cast on 121(127,133,139,143,149,155)sts and work in **single rib patt** for 6cm end with a WSF. Change to 4mm ns and cont straight in st st and when work measures 43(43,43,45,44,44,44)cm from beg end with a WSR, SHAPE RAGLANS: **1st Row:** P4, k1, skpo, k to last 7sts, k2tog, k1 p4.

2nd Row: K4, p1, p2tog, p to last 7sts, p2tog tbl, p1, k4. Rep last 2 rows 42(44,47,48,51,51,51)times more = 35(37,37,41,39,45,51)sts. Cast off rem sts.

FRONT:

Work as for back until 55(57,68,61,59,65,71) sts rem [work should measure 64(66,68,70,72,72,72)cm from beg, end with a WSR].

SHAPE NECK: RSF, cont raglan shaping as before, work to centre 13sts, leave first half of sts on a stitch holder, cast off centre 13sts and cont on rem sts for left side of work.

LEFT SIDE: Work one row **Cast off 5sts at beg (neck edge) of next and foll alt row 1(2,2,2,1,2,3)times in all, 4sts at beg of foll alt row 1(0,0,1,2,2,2)times, 2sts at beg of foll alt row 3(3,3,2,2,1,0)times, then dec 1st (= work 2tog) at beg of every foll alt row until 2sts rem, k2tog, fasten off.

RIGHT SIDE: WSF, rejoin yarn at neck edge, pick up sts from holder and work as for left side from ** to end.

SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE):

Using 3.25mm ns cast on (61,65,69,73,73,77,77)sts and work in **single rib patt** for 5cm end with a WSR. Change to 4mm ns and work in st st inc 1st at each end of every foll 4th row 4(4,8,5,13,12,9)times, then every foll 6th row 17(17,15,17,12,12,15) times = 103(107,115,117,123,125,125)sts. Cont straight and when work measures 46(47,47,47,48,48,49)cm from beg end a WSR, **SHAPE RAGLANS:**

1st Row: P4,k1,skpo, k to last 7sts, k2tog, k1, p4.

2nd Row: K4, p1,p2tog, p to last 7sts, p2tog tbl, p1, k4. Rep last 2 rows 42(44,47,48,51,51,51)times = 17(17,19,19,19,21,21)sts. Cast off rem sts.

TO MAKE UP:

FRONT RAGLAN PLEAT: RSF, using 3.25mm ns, pick up and

k60(66,70,70,76,76,76)sts evenly along cast off edge of front raglan. Work in st st for 3cm end with a RSR.

Now make pleat: WSF, *(with right hand n, pick up loop of next st 7 rows below, place on left-hand n, then ptog picked up loop and next st on left-hand n, rep from * to end.

Cast off all sts. Work the same for other front raglan. Sew raglan seams, leaving right back raglan seam open.

NECKBAND: RSF, using 3.25mm ns, pick up and k37(39,39,43,41,47,53)sts across back neck, 17(17,19,19,21,21)sts across top of left sleeve,

56(58,58,64,64,70,80)sts around front neck and 17(17,19,19,19,21,21)sts across top of right sleeve

= 127(131,135,145,143,159,175)sts. Cont in straight **single rib** for 3cm end with a WSR, cast off all sts RW. Sew right back raglan seam and neckband ends. Sew up side and sleeve seams.
