



ORIGINAL GARMENT: Size 82 - 87cm

To Fit Bust :	82 - 87cm	92 - 97cm	102 - 107cm	112 - 117cm
Actual Measurement : Bust	112cm	122cm	132cm	140cm
Length to Shoulder :	65cm	66cm	67cm	68cm
Sleeve Length :	47cm	48cm	49cm	50cm

MATERIALS:

16(18,20,22) balls JOY 50g colour 1274
One pair each 3.25mm and 4mm knitting needles
One stitch holder

TENSION:

22sts x 40 rows = 10cm over Trellis stitch using 4mm needles.
22sts x 30 rows = 10cm over stocking stitch using 4mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt – alternate; **beg** – begin(ning);
cont – continue; **dec** – decrease; **fol** – follow(ing); **inc(s)** – increase; **k** – knit;
patn(s) – pattern(s); **p** – purl; **rem** – remain(ing); **rep** – repeat; **rev** – reverse;
R(W)S – right (wrong) side; **R(W)SF** – right (wrong) side facing; **R(W)SR** – right (wrong) side row; **RW** – ribwise; **st(s)** – stitch(es); **st st** – stocking stitch; **sl** – slip; **tog** – together

Special Note: When working side seams tog, work from right side to make sure the rows match.

STITCHES USED:

DOUBLE RIB PATTERN:

Row 1: *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.
Row 2: *P2, K2, rep from * to last 2sts, P2.
Rep these 2 rows.

STOCKING STITCH:

Row 1: RSF – one row K.
Row 2: WSF – one row P.
Rep these 2 rows.

TRELLIS STITCH: (Worked over a multiple of 6sts + 5sts)

Row 1: RSF - K1, P3, *keeping yarn at front of work sl 3sts purlwise, P3; rep from *to last st, K1.
Row 2: P1, K3, *keeping yarn at back of work sl 3sts purlwise, K3; rep from * to last st, P1.
Row 3: K1, P3, *K3, P3, rep from * to last st, K1.
Row 4: P1, K3, *P3, K3, rep from * to last st, P1.

Row 5: K5, *insert point of right-hand needle upwards under the 2 strands in front of the sl sts and knit the next st, then lift the 2 strands off over the point of the right needle (called pull the loop), K5; rep from * to end.

Row 6: K1, p3, *K3, P3, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 7: P1, *keeping yarn at front sl 3sts purlwise, P3; rep from * to last 4sts, sl 3sts purlwise, P1.

Row 8: K1, *keeping yarn at back sl 3sts purlwise, K3; rep from * to last 4sts, sl 3sts purlwise, K1.

Row 9: P1, K3, *P3, K3; rep from * to last st, P1.

Row 10: K1, P3, *K3, P3, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 11: K2, *pull up loop (see row 5), K5, rep from * to last 3sts, pull up loop, K2.

Row 12: P1, K3, *P3, K3 rep from * to last st, P1.
Rep these 12 rows.

BACK:

Using 4mm needles cast on 125(137,149,155)sts and work in st st for 3cm ending with a WSR. Now cont straight in Trellis st patt (SEE STS USED) until work measures 65(66,67,68)cm from beg ending with a WSR, cast off all sts. Mark centre 65(65,69,69)sts with a coloured thread for neck opening.

FRONT:

Work as for back and when work measures 50(51,52, 53)cm from beg ending with a WSR, **SHAPE NECK:** Work 58(64,69,72)sts and leave on a holder, cast off center 9(9,11,11)sts for neck opening and cont on rem sts for left side of work. **LEFT SIDE:** Work one row. Cast off 8sts at beg (neck edge) of next row, 6sts at same edge on foll row, 4sts at beg of foll alt row, 3sts at beg of foll alt row, 2sts at beg of foll alt row 3 times, then dec 1 st (=work 2tog) at beg of foll alt row 1(1,2,2) times = 30(36,40,43)sts. Cont straight and when work measures 65(66,67,68)cm from beg ending with a WSR, cast odd all sts. **RIGHT SIDE:** WSF – re-join yarn at neck

edge, pick up sts from holder and work as for left side, rev shaping.

SLEEVES (Both alike):

Using 4mm needles cast on 74(78,80,82) sts and work in st st for 2cm ending with a WSR. Cont in st st, inc 1 st at each end of every following 4th row 5(6,11,15) times, then every 6th row 18(18,15,13) times = 120(126,132,138)sts. Cont straight and when work measures 47(48,49,50)cm from beg ending with a WSR, cast off all sts.

TO FINISH:

Sew right shoulder seam. **NECKBAND:** RSF – using 3.25mm needles, pick up and K136(136,144,144)sts around neck opening of front and 66(66,70,70)sts across back neck = 202(202,214,214)sts. WSF – work in double rib patt, beg with K2, for 5cm ending with a WSR, cast off all sts RW. Sew left shoulder seam and neckband ends. Set in sleeves. Sew up side and sleeve seams. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
