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AE - 1020 BOY'S PULLOVER

ORIGINAL GARMENT: 3 - 4 YEARS OLD

To Fit Chest:	54cm	58cm	62cm	65cm	
Actual Measurements - Chest	62cm	70cm	74cm	78cm	
Length:	60cm	60cm	65cm	65cm	
Sleeve Seam:	47cm	47cm	48cm	49cm	

MATERIALS:

5 (6, 7, 7) balls of **JOY**, colour 1088 (Main Colour)
2 (2, 3, 3) balls of Joy, colour 1223 (Contrasting Colour)
4mm Crochet Hook

TENSION:

17 sts x 14 rows = 10cm working with a 4mm hook and in htr's (unblocked)

ABBREVIATIONS: (UK terminology used) **2htrtog** – two half trebles together **2dctog** – two double crochet together

Beg – begin/ing **CC** – contrasting colour

Ch - chain

Cont - continue

Dc - double crochet

Htr - half treble

MC - main colour

RS – right side

Sk – skip

Slst – slip stitch

St – stitch

WS – wrong side

PATTERN NOTES: The pullover is designed to be a fairly loose fit, with easily adjustable body and sleeve lengths. Start each dc/htr row with a ch1. This does not count as a stitch. (Be careful not to work in the ch1; if you're a beginner, do frequent stitch counts). DO NOT weave in the ends on the bodice, including the neckline. Follow the step by step instructions under Finish Up. If the ends are woven in first, the fit will be altered.

BACK:

With 4.00mm hook and CC, loosely make 54 (62, 66, 70) ch.

Row 1: (RS) Insert hook in the 2nd chain from hook and make 1dc. Work 1dc in each ch across, turn. 53 (61, 65, 69) sts **Row 2:** Ch1, work 1dc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Repeat prev row another 6 times. Fasten off.

Next row: Join MC and ch1, work 1htr in each st across, turn.

Next rows: Work in htr rows until piece measures 23 (27, 29, 32) cm, ending with a RS row. Fasten off and turn.**

Shape Armholes: All sizes

Next row: With WS facing and CC, sk first 2 sts, work 1dc in each st across, leaving last 2 sts unworked. Fasten off and turn.

***Next row: With MC, 2htrtog, work 1 htr in each st across to last 2 sts, 2htrtog. Fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, 2dctog, work 1dc in each st across to last 2sts, 2dctog. Fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, 2htrtog, work 1 htr in each st across to last 2sts, 2htrtog. Fasten off and turn.

Rep previous 2 rows, once more. 39 (47, 51, 55) sts.***

Next rows: Continue with the colour changes and pattern as set and work another 8 (9, 10, 10) rows.

NECKLINE: Size 1 - 2 Only: **RIGHT SIDE:**

Next row: With CC, work 1dc across the next 11 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, work 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog. Fasten off. (10 sts) **LEFT SIDE:** Leave the middle 17 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.

NECKLINE: Size 3 - 4 Only: **RIGHT SIDE:**

Next row: With MC, work 1 htr across the next 13 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 2dctog, 1dc in each st across, fasten off and turn. **Next row:** With MC, work 1htr in each st across to last 2 sts, 2htrtog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 2dctog, 1dc in each st across. Fasten off. (10 sts) **LEFT SIDE:** Leave the middle 21 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.

NECKLINE: Size 4 - 5 Only: **RIGHT SIDE:**

Next row: With CC, work 1dc across the next 16 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, work 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and turn

Next row: With MC, work 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog. Fasten off. (14 sts) **LEFT SIDE:** Leave the middle 19 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.

NECKLINE: Size 6 - 7 Only:

RIGHT SIDE:

Next row: With CC, work 1dc across the next 17 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, work 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and

Next row: With MC, work 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog. Fasten off. (15 sts) **LEFT SIDE:** Leave the middle 21 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.

FRONT:

Work as for back from ** - **.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: All Sizes

Next row: With CC, sk first 2 sts, work 1dc in each st to last 18 sts, ch10, sk next 10 sts (pocket opening created) work 1 dc in each st across, leaving last 2 sts unworked. Fasten off and turn.

Next row: Work as for back from *** - ***. **Next rows:** Continue with the colour changes and pattern as set and work another 6 rows.

NECKLINE: Size 1 - 2 Only:

RIGHT SIDE:

Next row: With CC, work 1dc across the next 14 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, work 2htrtog, 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn. **Next row:** With CC, work 1dc in each st

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, 2htrtog, 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog. Fasten off. (10 sts) **LEFT SIDE:** Leave the middle 11 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.



AE - 1020 **BOY'S PULLOVER**

NECKLINE: Size 3 - 4 Only:

RIGHT SIDE:

Next row: With CC, work 1dc across the next 16 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, work 2htrtog, 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and

turn.

Next row: With MC, work 2htrtog, 1 htr in each st across, fasten off and turn. Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and

Next row: With MC, work 2htrtog, 1htr in each st across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1 dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog. Fasten off. (10sts) **LEFT SIDE**: Leave the middle 15 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.

NECKLINE: Size 4 - 5 Only:

RIGHT SIDE:

Next row: With CC, work 1dc across the

next 18 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, work 1htr in each st

across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and

Next rows: Repeat the previous 2 rows another 3 times. Fasten off. (14sts) LEFT SIDE: Leave the middle 15 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.

NECKLINE: Size 6 - 7 Only:

RIGHT SIDE:

Next row: With CC, work 1dc across the next 19 sts, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, work 1htr in each st

across, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, work 1dc in each st across to last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and

Next rows: Rep the previous 2 rows another 3 times. LEFT SIDE: Leave the middle 17 sts unworked, join yarn in the next st. Work exactly as for the right side, reversing all shapings.

SLEEVES: (Make 2)

With 4mm hook and CC, loosely make 31 (31, 35, 35) ch.

Row 1: (RS) Insert hook in the 2nd chain from hook and make 1dc. Work 1dc in each ch across, turn. 30 (30, 34, 34) sts Row 2: Ch1, work 1dc in each st across, turn

Row 9: With MC, work 1 htr in each st

Row 3: 8: Repeat prev row. Fasten off. across, turn

Row 10: Repeat prev row.

Row 11: Cont working in htr's and increase one st at the beg and end of the row, turn **Next rows:** Rep row 9 - 11 another 5 (6, 7, 1)7) times. 42 (44, 50, 50) sts

Next rows: Cont straight until sleeve measures 23 (29, 31, 33) cm or preferred length, ending with a RS row. Fasten off.

SHAPE SLEEVECAP: Size 1-2

Next row: With CC, sk the first 2 sts, work 1dc in each st across, leaving last 2 sts unworked, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, 2htrtog, 1htr in each st across to the last 2 sts, 2htrtog, fasten off

Next row: With CC, 2dctog, 1dc in each st across to the last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: Rep prev 2 rows once more. Next row: With MC, sk 1st, 2htrtog, work 1htr in each st across to the last 3 sts, 2htrtog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, sk 1st, 2dctog, work 1dc in each st across to the last 3 sts, 2dctog. Fasten off. (22 sts)

SHAPE SLEEVECAP: Size 3 - 4

Next row: With CC, sk the first 2 sts, work 1dc in each st across, leaving last 2 sts unworked, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, 2htrtog, 1htr in each st across to the last 2 sts, 2htrtog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, 2dctog, 1dc in each st across to the last 2 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: Rep prev 2 rows once more. Next row: With MC, 2htrtog, 1htr in each st across to the last 2 sts, 2htrtog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, sk 1st, 2dctog, work 1dc in each st across to the last 3 sts, 2dctog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With MC, sk 1st, 2htrtog, work 1htr in each st across to the last 3 sts, 2htrtog, fasten off and turn.

Next row: With CC, sk 1st, 2dctog, work 1dc in each st across to the last 3 sts, 2dctog. Fasten off. (18 sts)

SHAPE SLEEVECAP: Size 4 – 5 & 6 - 7 **Next rows:** Rep as for size 3 - 4. Next row: With MC, sk 1st, 2htrtog, work 1htr in each st across to the last 3 sts, 2htrtog, fasten off and turn. (20 sts)

FINISH UP:

POCKET LINER: With WS facing, join CC in the remaining loops of the first ch. Work 1htr in each ch across. Work 6 more rows, fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew in position, making sure that the stitches don't show through on the right side of

the work. With right sides facing, join the shoulders.

Fold the sleeves in half lenathways. Place the midway point on the shoulder seam, right sides facing, pin in place and sew together. Weave in all the remaining ends on the bodice and sleevecaps.

NECKBAND:

With RS facing, join CC at the back. Work 1 round of equally spaced dc all round, close with a slst. Work 4 more rounds in dc. (For a smaller or bigger neck opening, simply work more or few rounds.)

Turn the garment inside out, weave in all the remaining loose ends around the neck. Join the sleeve and side seams and weave in all remaining loose ends. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth (or spray with water) and allow to dry.
