

ORIGINAL GARMENT: ONE SIZE FITS MOST

## MATERIALS:

2 balls JOY 50g in colour 1022 - colour 1 5 balls JOY 50 g in colour 1278 - colour 2 3 balls JOY 50g in colour 1286 - colour 3 2 balls JOY 50g in colour 1613 - colour 4 4.50 mm crochet hook

Tapestry Needle

## COMPLETED MEASUREMENTS:

(Length between V-neck and point) 54 cm

## GAUGE:

Each block measures $45 \times 45 \mathrm{~cm}$ using a 4.50 mm hook.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

C1 - colour 1; C2 - colour 2; C3-colour 3; C4 - colour 4; ch - chain; dc - double crochet; dtr - double treble; htr - half treble; sk - skip; slst - slip stitch; st/s - stitch/es tr - treble

## IMPORTANT PATTERN NOTES:

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Work ch1 at the beginning of dc and htr rounds. This does not count as a stitch.
- Work ch3 at the beginning of tr rounds. This counts as a stitch.
- Work ch4 at the beginning of dtr rounds. This counts as a stitch.
- The post of a stitch refers to the actual body of a stitch.


## INSTRUCTIONS:

BLOCKS: (make 6)
With a 4.50 mm hook and C1, ch4, close with a slst OR make a magic circle.

Round 1: Ch3, work 11 tr in ring, close with a slst. (12sts)
Round 2: Ch3, 1 tr at the base of the ch3, 2 tr in each tr around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch. Fasten off. (24sts)
Round 3: With C2, join yarn in any st, ch3, 1 tr at the base of the ch3, ch 1 , sk next st, *2tr in the next st, ch 1, sk next st*, rep from * all around, fasten off. (36sts)

Round 4: With C3, join yarn in the 1st tr of any 2 tr -grouping, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ in the same st, $1 d c$ in the next st, 2 tr in the next unworked st of round $3, * 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next unworked st of round $3^{*}$, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the first st. (48 sts)
Round 5: Ch3, 1 tr in the next 2 sts, 2 tr in the next st, ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 3 sts, 2 tr in the next st*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch, fasten off. ( 60 sts )

Round 6: With C4, join yarn in any st, ch3 1 tr in the next 3 sts, ch2, sk next st, ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 4 sts, ch2, sk next st*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch, fasten off. (72 sts)
Round 7: With C2, join yarn in the 1st tr of any 4 tr-grouping, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ in the same st, 1 dc in the next 3sts, 2 tr in the next unworked st of round $6,{ }^{*}$ 1dc in the next 4 sts, $2 t r$ in the next unworked st of round 6*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the first st, fasten off. (72 sts)
Round 8: With C1, ch3, 1 tr in the next 4 sts, 2 tr in the next st, *1tr in the next 5 sts, 2 tr in the next st*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch. (84 sts).
Round 9: Ch3, 1 tr in the next 5 sts, 2 tr in the next st, * 1 tr in the next 6 sts, 2 tr in the next st*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch, fasten off. (96 sts).
Round 10: With C3, join yarn between any 2 sts, ch1, 1 htr in the same sp, work 1 htr between each st all around, close with a slst in the first st, fasten off. (96 sts)
Round 11: With C4, join yarn in any st, ch 1 work 1 htr in the same st and every st around, close with a slst in the first st. (96 sts)
Round 12: Ch3, 1 tr in the next 6 sts, 2 tr in the next st, * 1 tr in the next 7 sts, 2 tr in the next st*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch, fasten off. (108 sts)
Round 13: With C2, ch3, 1 tr in the next 7 sts, $2 t r$ in the next st, * 1 tr in the next 8 sts, 2 tr in the next $\mathrm{st}^{*}$, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch, fasten off. ( 120 sts)
Round 14: With C3, join yarn in any st, ch4, 1 dtr at the base of the ch4, *1dtr in the next 2 sts, 1 tr in the next 2 sts, 1 htr in the next 3 sts, 1 dc in the next 15 sts, 1 htr in the next 3 sts, 1 tr in the next 2 sts, 1 dtr in the next 2 sts, (2dtr, ch2, 2dtr) (corner made) in the next st*, rep from * all around, omitting the corner from the last rep, 2 dtr in the same sp as the starting corner, close with a htr in the 4th ch. (33 sts per side, 4 corner spaces)
Round 15: Ch3, 1 tr around the post of the htr from the prev round, 1 tr in each st to the next corner, * $2 t r$, ch2, $2 t r$ ) in the next corner sp, 1 tr in each st to the next corner*, rep from * all around, work 2 tr in the starting corner, ch2, close with a slst in the 3 rd ch, fasten off. ( 37 sts per side, 4 corner spaces)
Round 16: With C1, join yarn in any cornersp. Ch3, 1 tr in the same sp, sk next st, 2 tr in next st, sk next st, * $2 t r$, ch2, $2 t r$ ) in next
corner-sp, (2tr in next st, sk next st) rep to next corner sp*, rep from * all around, work 2tr in the starting corner-sp, ch2, close with a slst in the 3rd ch, fasten off. (40 sts per side, 4 corner spaces)
Round 17-18: With C2 join yarn in any corner and rep round 15. Fasten off. (48 sts per side, 4 corner spaces)
Round 19: With C4, rep round 15. Fasten off. (52 sts per side, 4 corner spaces)
Round 20: With C3, rep round 15. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. (56 sts per side, 4 corner spaces)

Using the picture as a guide, sew all the blocks in place. Weave in all loose ends.

## HOOD EDGING:

With C2 work one round of dc.

## BOTTOM EDGING:

With C2 work one round of htr.

## FINISHING:

Weave in all remaining loose ends. Block to measurement. (Pin garment, spray with water and leave to dry.)
