

EASY EYELET PULLOVER

IMPORTANT NOTE: Unless yarn specified is used, African Expressions cannot accept the responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

Original garment worked in size 87cm and shown on a size 87cm model.

MATERIALS: LOVE (50g balls)

7(8;9) balls 3029. One pair each 5,5mm and 6mm knitting needles.

MEASUREMENTS:

To fit Bust: 82(87;92)cm

Actual all round measurement of garment: Bust: 84(88;92)cm

Length to shoulder: 54(56;58)cm

THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE SMALLEST SIZE, WITH THE LARGER SIZES IN BRACKETS; WHERE ONLY ONE FIGURE IS GIVEN, IT APPLIES TO ALL SIZES.

TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

18sts and 20 rows = 10cm over Double Eyelet Pattern using 6mm needles.

FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.

IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;

IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg = begin(ning); cont = continue; dec = decrease; k =
knit; patt(s) = pattern(s); p = purl; rep = repeat; R(W)SF
= right(wrong) side facing; R(W)SR = right(wrong) side
row; RW = ribwise; st(s) = stitch(es); SKPO = slip one,
knit one, pass slipped stitch over; tog = together; yfd =
yarn forward.

STITCHES USED:

FANCY RIB PATTERN: **1st row:** K5, *p2, k5, rep from * to end. **2nd row:** P5, *k2, p5, rep from * to end. Rep these 2 rows. DOUBLE EYELET PATTERN (Worked over a multiple of 7sts + 2sts):

1st row: RSF, p2, *k5, p2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: K2, *p5, k2, rep from * to end.

3rd row: P2, *k2tog, yfd, k1, yfd, SKPO, p2, rep from * to end.

4th row: Work as 2nd row. Rep these 4 rows.

FRONT AND BACK RIBBINGS (Both Alike):

Using 5,5mm needles cast on 75(82;89)sts and work in Fancy Rib Patt (SEE STS USED) for 17(18;19)cm ending with a WSR, cast off all sts RW.

CUFF RIBBINGS (Make 2):

Using 5,5mm needles cast on 47sts and work in Fancy Rib patt for 10(11;12)cm ending with a WSR, cast off all sts RW.

FRONT AND BACK PANELS (Both Alike):

Using 6mm needles cast on 65(65;72)sts and cont straight in Double Eyelet Patt (SEE STS USED) until work measures 124(126;128)cm from beg ending with a WSR. Cast off all sts.

TO MAKE UP:

RSF to inside, sew centre of front and back panels to ribbings. Mark centre 27(29;31)cm on front and back for neck openings. Sew shoulder seams to markers of neck. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew cuff ribbings to sleeves (easing sleeves to fit). Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
