


AE - 3014 CROCHET | FREE PATTERN





AE - 3014 WAISTCOAT

ORIGINAL GARMENT: SIZE 34

To Fit Chest:	82cm	87cm	92cm	97cm
Measurements all Round Chest:	87cm	92cm	97cm	102cm
Length to Shoulder:	58cm	58cm	58cm	58cm

MATERIALS:

2 (2, 2, 3) balls of **Love** Colour 3079 1 ball **Love** Colour 3077 8mm Crochet Hook

TENSION: (UNBLOCKED)

9sts x 5 rows = 10cm using a 8mm hook.

ABBREVIATIONS: (UK TERMINOLOGY USED)

Beg – begin/ing Ch – chain Chsp – chain space Cont – continue Dc – double crochet RS – right side Picot – ch3, slst in first ch Sk – skip Slst – slip stitch St – stitch Tr - treble WS – wrong side

PATTERN NOTES:

Pattern is written in UK terminology. Start tr rounds with a ch3. This counts as a stitch. Start dc rounds with ch1. This doesn't count as a stitch. The body is done all in one, and is then divided between fronts and back. The back is completed first.

TO MAKE: BODY:

Using a 8mm hook and colour 3079 ch 76 (84, 92, 100)

Row 1: (RS) Insert hook in the 6th ch from hook and work 1tr, ch1, sk next ch, *1tr in next ch, sk next tr, ch1*, rep from * to last ch, 1tr in last ch, turn. 73 (81, 89, 97) sts. **Row 2:** Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to end, 1tr in last tr, turn.

Next rows: Rep row 2 another 11 times. (13 rows in total) Fasten off.

BACK:

Next row: Sk the first 22 (24, 26, 28) sts, insert hook in next st, ch3, sk next chsp, (1tr in next tr, ch1) 12 (14, 16, 18) times, 1tr in next tr, sk next chsp, 1tr in next tr, turn. 27 (31, 35, 39) sts.

Next row: Ch4 (count as 1tr, ch1), sk 2nd

tr, *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to two last tr's, sk second last tr, 1tr in last tr, turn. 25 (29, 33, 37) sts.

Next row: Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to end, 1tr in last tr, turn.

Next rows: Rep prev row another 7 times. Fasten off. (back rows = 10 rows in total)

LEFT SIDE:

With WS facing, join yarn in first st on the left.

Next row: Ch3, sk next chsp, (1tr in next tr, ch1) 5 (6, 7, 8) times, 1tr in next tr, sk next chsp, 1tr in next tr, turn. 13 (15, 17, 19) sts. **Next row:** Ch4 (count as 1tr, ch1), sk 2nd tr, *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to two last tr's, sk second last tr, 1tr in last tr, turn. 11 (13, 15, 17) sts.

Next row: Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to end, 1tr in last tr, turn.

Next row: Rep prev row. Next row: Ch3, sk next chsp, *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to end, 1tr in last tr, turn. 10 (12, 14, 16) sts

Next row: Ch4 (count as 1tr, ch1), sk next chsp, *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to last 2 tr, sk 2nd last tr, 1tr in last tr, turn. 9 (11, 13, 15) sts

Next row: Ch4 (count as 1tr, ch1), *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to end, 1tr in last tr, turn.

Next row: Ch3, *ch1, 1tr in next tr* rep from * to 2nd last tr, 1tr in last tr, turn. 8 (10, 12, 14) sts

Next row: Ch4 (count as 1tr, ch1), sk 2nd tr, *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to last tr, 1tr in last tr, turn. 7 (9, 11, 13) sts **Next row:** Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), *1tr in next tr, ch1*, rep from * to end, 1tr in last tr. Fasten off.

RIGHT SIDE:

With WS facing, sk the next 7 sts to the left of the back, join yarn in the 8th st. Work exactly as for the left side, reversing the neckline shapings. Fasten off.

BORDER:

With RS facing, and colour 3077, join yarn in first st on the left. **Row 1:** Ch1, work 1dc in each ch and st across, turn. 73 (81, 89, 97) sts

Row 2: Ch1, 1dc in first dc, *ch1, sk next 3dc, (1tr, ch3, 1tr, ch3, 1tr) in next dc, ch1, sk next 3 dc, 1dc in next dc*, repeat from * across to end, turn.

Row 3: Ch1, 1dc in first dc, *5tr in next 3chsp, 3picots, 5tr in next 3chsp, 1dc in next dc*, rep from * to end. Fasten off.

FINISH OFF:

Before sewing the shoulders seams, block the garment according to the completed measurements. Pin in place, spray with water and leave to dry.

Sew the shoulder seams.

EDGING:

With colour 3079 and an 8.00mm hook, work 1 round of evenly spaced dc around the front and neckline, omitting the border. Work 1 round of evenly spaced dc around the armholes.

Weave in all loose ends.
