## MATERIALS:

9(10,10,11,11,12,13,14) Balls SOUL 50g Colour - 7289

## 3.5 mm Crochet hook

## TENSION:

23 sts $\times 12$ rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ using a 3.5 mm crochet hook and working in trebles.

2triog - two treble together
3 triog - three treble together

## STITCHES USED:

## Cluster shell:

In the same stitch work: 3trtog, 2ch, 3trtog, 2ch, 3trtog.

## V-stitch:

In the same stitch work: Tr, 2ch, tr.

## PATTERN:

BACK:
With a 3.5 mm hook make
98(106,114,122,130,138,146,154)ch.
$1^{\text {st }}$ Row: (RS) Insert hook in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ from hook, make dc, *ch, sk next 3ch, cl-sh in next ch, ch, sk next 3ch, dc in next ch*, rep from * to end, turn.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Row: 3ch ( $=\mathrm{tr}$ ), tr in base of $3 \mathrm{ch},{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{ch}$, dc in $2^{\text {nd }} 3$ trtog of cl-sh, $2 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ tr in next dc *, rep from * to last cl-sh, 2ch, dc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ 3 trtog of last cl-sh, 2ch, 2 tr in last dc, turn. $3^{\text {rd }}$ Row: 2ch, (htr, 2ch, 3rtog) in the base of $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{ch},{ }^{*}$ dc in next dc, ch, sk next tr, cl -sh in next tr, ch*, rep from * to last dc, dc in last dc, ch, (3trtog, 2ch, 2trtog) in last st, turn.
$4^{\text {th }}$ Row: Ch, dc in first 2trtog, *2ch, 3tr in
next dc, 2ch, dc in $2^{\text {nd }} 3$ trtog of cl-sh*, rep from * to end, working the last dc in the 2trtog of prev row, turn.
$5^{\text {th }}$ Row: Ch, dc in first dc, *ch, sk next tr, cl-sh in next tr, ch, dc in next dc*, rep from* to end, turn.
$6^{\text {th }}-9^{\text {th }}$ Row: Rep $2^{\text {nd }}-5^{\text {th }}$ row.
10 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: Rep $2^{\text {nd }}$ row.
11 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: Ch ( $=$ not $1^{\text {st }}$ st ), htr at the base of the ch, htr in next tr, 2htr in next 2chsp, htr in next dc, 2htr in next 2chsp, *htr in next 3tr, 2htr in next 2chsp, htr in next dc, 2htr in next 2chsp*, rep from * to last 2sts, htr in last 2tr, turn
$=97(105,113,121,129,137,145,153) \mathrm{htr}$.

## Size 32, 38 \& 44 ONLY:

12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 3ch ( $=\mathrm{tr}$ ), *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from * to end, turn
$=97(121,145)$ sts.

## Size 34, 40 \& 46 ONLY:

12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 3ch ( $=$ tr), sk next htr, tr in next htr, *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from

* to last 2sts, sk next htr, tr in last htr, turn
$=103(127,151)$ sts.


## Size 36 \& 42 ONLY:

12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 3ch ( $=\mathrm{tr}$ ), tr in the base of the 3ch *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from * to end 2 tr in last htr, turn $=115$ (139)sts.

## ALL SIZES:

NOTE:
Ch does not count as a stitch in below pattern.
$13^{\text {th }}$ Row: Ch, dc in each tr and chsp across.
14 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: Ch, dc in first st, 2ch, sk next 2dc, $V$-st in next dc, *2ch, sk next 2dc, dc in next dc, 2ch, sk next 2dc, V-st in next dc*, rep from * to end, 2ch, sk next 2dc, dc in last st, turn.
15 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: Ch, htr in base of ch, * ch, cl-sh in next $V$-st*, rep from * to end, ch, htr in last st, turn.
16 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 4ch ( $=\mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch}$ ), * rr in next 2chsp, ch, tr in next 2chsp, ch, tr in next chsp, ch*, rep from * to end, working last tr in last htr of prev row, turn.
17 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 4ch ( $=\mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch}$ ), *rr in next tr, ch*, rep to end, tr in last tr, turn.
$18^{\text {th }}$ Row: Ch, dc in first st, 2ch, sk next 2sts, V-st in next st, *2ch, sk next 2sts, dc in next st, 2ch, sk next 2sts, V-st in next st*, rep from * to end, 2ch, sk next 2sts, dc in last
st, turn.
19 th $-58^{\text {th }}$ Row: Rep $15^{\text {th }}-18^{\text {th }}$ row ( 10 times).
$59^{\text {th }}-61^{\text {st }}$ Row: Rep $15^{\text {th }}-17^{\text {th }}$ row once.
62 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ Row: 4ch (= tr, ch), *tr in next tr, ch*, rep to end, tr in last tr, turn.
63 ${ }^{\text {dd }}$ Row: 3ch ( $=\mathrm{tr}$ ), tr in each
chsp and tr across, turn =
97(103,115,121,127,139,145,151)tr.
$64^{\text {th }}-75^{\text {th }}$ Row: Rep $62^{\text {nd }}-63^{\text {rd }}$ row(6 times).

## SHAPE ARMHOLE:

76 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: SI st over first 4sts and cont in established patt to end, leaving last 4sts unworked
$=89(95,107,113,119,131,137,143)$ sts.
77 ${ }^{\text {th }}-97^{\text {th }}$ Row: Cont in established patt.
Size 32, 34, 36 \& 38:
Fasten off.
Size 40 \& 42:
Work one row and fasten off.

## Size 44 \& 46:

Work two rows and fasten off.

## LEFT FRONT:

With 3.5 mm hook, make
50(58,58, 66,66,74,74,82)ch.
$1^{\text {st }}-11^{\text {th }}$ Row: Work as for back
$=49(57,57,65,65,73,73,81)$ sts.

## Size 32, 42 \& 44 ONLY:

12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 3ch (= tr), *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from * to end, turn $=49$ (73,73)sts.

## Size 34 ONLY:

12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 3 ch ( $=$ tr), sk next htr, tr in next htr, *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from * to last 2sts, sk next htr, tr in last htr, turn = 55sts.

## Size 36 \& 46 ONLY:

$12^{\text {th }}$ Row: 3ch ( $=\mathrm{tr}$ ), tr in the base of the 3ch, ch, sk next htr, 2 tr in next htr *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from * to last $2 h t r, ~ c h, 2 t r$ in next htr, ch, 2tr in last htr, turn $=61$ (85)sts.

## Size 38 \& 40 ONLY:

$12^{\text {th }}$ Row: $3 \mathrm{ch}(=\mathrm{tr})$, tr in the base of the 3ch *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from * to end, 2 tr in last htr, turn $=67 \mathrm{sts}$.
$13^{\text {th }}-61^{\text {st }}$ Row: Work as for back.

## SHAPE NECKLINE:

62 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ Row: 3ch ( $=\dagger$ tr), sk next chsp, tr in next tr ( $={ }^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dec}$ ), *ch, tr in next tr*, rep from * across, turn $=54$ sts.
$63^{\text {rd }}-75^{\text {th }}$ Row: Work as for back, AT THE SAME TIME dec 1st at the neckline on every row, turn $=41$ sts.

## SHAPE ARMHOLE:

76th Row: 3ch (= tr), sk next tr, tr in next tr ( $1^{\text {st }}$ dec made at neckline), cont in established patt across, leaving last 4sts unworked, turn = 36 sts.
$77^{\text {th }}-97^{\text {th }}$ Row: Cont working in established patt, dec 1st at neckline and stop dec when $25(27,29,31,33,35,37,39)$ sts rem. Cont further in established patt without any further dec at neckline.

Size 32, 34, 36 \& 38:
Fasten off.

Size 40 \& 42:
Work one row and fasten off.
Size 44 \& 46:
Work two rows and fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT:

Work exactly as for left front, but rev all shapings.

## SLEEVES (MAKE 2):

With a 3.5 mm crochet hook make 58ch. $1^{\text {st }}-11^{\text {th }}$ Row: Work as for back $=57 \mathrm{sts}$. 12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Row: 3ch (= tr), *ch, sk next htr, tr in next htr*, rep from * to end, turn.
13 th Row: 3ch (= tr), work tr in each tr and chsp across, turn.
14 $4^{\text {th }}$ Row onwards: Rep $12^{\text {th }}-13^{\text {th }}$ row, AT THE SAME TIME, inc 1st at the beg and end of next and every alt 3 rd row a total of $14(14,14,14,15,15,16,16)$ times $=$ 85(85,85,85,87, 87, 89,89)sts.
Cont straight without any further shaping until the sleeve measures 55 cm .

## SHAPE FOR ARMHOLE:

Next row: Keeping continuity of patt, sl st over the first 4sts, cont across the row, leaving the last 4sts unworked $=$ 77(77,77,77,79,79,81,81)sts.
Fasten off.

## TO JOIN SLEEVE:

With right sides facing, join shoulder seams. Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds on shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position. Sew up side and sleeve seams.

## BOTTOM EDGING:

With a 3.5 mm hook and RS facing insert hook in first st and work an evenly spaced row of htr across the remaining loops of the foundation ch. Turn and work a second row of htr in each htr.
Fasten off.

## SLEEVE EDGING:

Work as for bottom edging.

## FRONT \& NECK EDGING:

Work as for bottom edging but do not fasten off after the $2^{\text {nd }}$ row. After turning work htr in each htr up the side up to the point where the V-shaping start for the neck, 51 ch , insert hook in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ from hook and work sl st in each ch = this will create the fastening loops.
Cont around the neck, and do the same for the left side at exactly the same spot as for the right side.
Finish the row and fasten off.

## NOTE:

## SIZE 32, 40 \& 44 ONLY:

Work exactly as stipulated above, but work 4 rows, instead of two. Then, work the last row as stipulated above to create the fastening loops.

## TO MAKE UP:

Weave in all loose ends. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth (or spray with water) and allow to dry.
