

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AE - 7006 SHORT SLEEVE CARDIGAN

ORIGINAL GARMENT: 87cm.

To Fit Bust	87cm	92cm	97cm	102cm	107cm
Measurement all Round	92cm	97cm	102cm	107cm	112cm
Length to Top	60cm	64cm	64cm	64cm	64cm
Sleeve Seam	13cm	13cm	13cm	13cm	13cm

MATERIALS:

6(6,7,7,8) Balls **SOUL** 50g

3mm Crochet hook 3.5mm Crochet hook

TENSION:

5patterns = 10cm using 3.5 mm hook and shell and picot pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg - begin (ning) dc - double crochet

ch - chain

chsp - chain space

dec - decrease

inc - increase

patt - pattern

rep - repeat

sk - skip

sl st - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es) tch - turning chain

tr - treble

R(W)S - right (wrong) side

yoh - yarn over hook

STITCHES USED:

CL (= cluster):

*Yoh, insert hook in specified st and draw a loop the high of a tr, yoh draw through 2 loops on hook. Rep from * to* once more in the same st, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook. (= 1 cluster). Shell: Work (1tr, ch) 3 times, tr, all in the same stitch.

Picot: 3ch, sl st in the dc.

SHELL AND PICOT PATTERN: (multiple of 6 + 2)

1st Row: (RS), Dc into 2nd ch from hook, dc into each ch to end of row.

2nd Row: 3ch (= tr) sk 2dc, shell in next dc * sk 5dc, shell in next dc, rep from * to last 3dc, sk 2dc, tr in last dc, turn.

3rd Row: 3ch *sk 2tr, (cl, 3ch, cl) in next chsp, sk 2tr, rep from * end with tr in tch. 4th Row: Ch, dc in first tr * 3ch, sk cl, tr in next chsp, 3ch, sk cl, dc between next 2 cl, 1picot, rep from * end with last dc in

5th Row: 3ch, sk 3ch, shell in next tr * sk

(3ch, picot, 3ch), shell in next tr, rep from * with 2nd or 4th row of patt. Fasten off. to end with tr in tch. Rep 3^{rd} - 5^{th} row (= patt).

Shell arches (multiple of 6 + 3):

1st Row: 3ch, tr in first dc,*2ch, sk 3dc tr in each of next 3dc, rep from* ending 2ch, sk, 3dc, trinto each of last 2dc.

2nd Row: Ch, dc in first tr * sk tr, 5tr in 2chsp, sk tr, dc in next tr, rep from * to end with dc in tch.

3rd Row: 4ch, sk, tr,* tr into each of next 3tr, 2ch sk (tr, dc, tr), rep from * end with tr into each of next 3tr, ch, tr in last dc.

4th Row: 3ch, 2tr in next chsp * sk tr, dc in next tr, sk, tr, 5tr in next chsp, rep from * ending sk tr. dc in next tr. sk tr. 2tr in tch. 5th Row: 3ch, tr in next tr * 2ch, sk (tr, dc, tr) tr in each of next 3tr, rep from * ending sk

Rep 2^{nd} - 5^{th} row (patt).

(tr, dc, tr), tr in next tr, tr in tch.

BACK:

With 3.5mm hook make 134(146,158,170,182)ch, and work work shell and picot patt from 1st - 5th row once, then from 3^{rd} - 5^{th} row until work measures 24cm from starting ch end with 4th row of

patt, 22(24,26,28,30)patts. **RIGHT SLEEVE

At the end of last row make 38ch and work across ch as follows:

Shell in 4th ch from hook, (sk 5ch, shell in next ch) 5 times then cont in patt to end of row **. Do not break yarn.

***LEFT SLEEVE

Fasten off

Using a separate strand of yarn make 36ch and join with a sI st at the end of row in last dc.

Return to yarn left in attendance and work across ch, sk 2ch, shell in next ch (sk 5ch, shell in next ch) 5 times, sk 2ch, tr in last ch ***34(36,38,40,42)patts. Cont in patt until sleeve measures 18(19,20,22,23)cm end with WS row.

LOWER BORDER OF BACK:

With WSF join yarn at lower edge of back and work as given for shell patt starting with 1st row, rep from 1st - 5th row until back measures about 60(60,64,64,64)cm end

LEFT FRONT:

With 3.5mm hook make 68(74,80,86,92)ch and work sheel and picot patt as given for back, 11(12,13,14,15)patts.

When work measures 24cm, end with 4th row of patt shape sleeve as given for right sleeve of back from ** to **. Cont in patt until front measure 11(11,11,12,12)cm less than back to shoulder line end with 4th row of patt.

SHAPE FRONT NECK:

Next row: Work to last 4(4,4,5,5)patt, turn and leave rem sts unworked. Cont on rem sts until front matches back to shoulder line. Fasten off.

LOWER BORDER:

Work as given for lower border of back.

RIGHT FRONT:

Work as given for left front rev shaping.

TO MAKE UP AND EDGES:

Join shoulders seam.

SLEEVE EDGING (BOTH ALIKE):

With WSF and 3mm hook join yarn at underarm seam and work 1 row dc along lower edge of sleeve, turn.

Next row: Dc in first st, * sk 2dc, 5tr in next dc (= shell), sk 2dc, dc in next dc, rep from * to end of row.

Join underarm and side seams.

FRONTS AND NECK EDGING:

With WSF using 3mm hook, join yarn at lower edge of left front and work 1 row dc evenly up left front, around front neck, back of neck, around right front neck, down right front edge, work 3dc into corners turn

Work 1 row of shells as given for sleeve edging.



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
