## MATERIALS:

$8(9,9,10)$ balls SOUL 50 g in colour 7169 3.75 mm Crochet Hook

Tapestry Needle

## GAUGE:

$22 \mathrm{sts} \times 13$ rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ using a 3.75 mm hook.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

ch - chain; chsp(s) - chain space(s); dc - double crochet; htr - half treble; rep repeat; RS - right side; slst - slip stitch; sk skip; sp(s) - space(s); tr - treble; yo - yarn over

## IMPORTANT PATTERN NOTES:

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Work chl at the beginning of dc rounds.

This doesn't count as a stitch.

- Work ch3 at the beginning of tr rounds. This counts as a stitch.
- Each chain in the stitch pattern count as a stitch.
- Post refer to the actual body of a stitch.
- Shell : (2tr, ch2, 2tr)
- When working the mesh st pattern: When turning, slst to the 1st chain space and start the next round here. OR work around the posts of the dc's or htr's that were used to close the previous round.


## INSTRUCTIONS:

Using a 3.75 mm hook, loosely make 132 ch. Close with a sist but be careful not to twist the ch.

Round 1: (RS) Ch4, (count as tr \& ch1) 1 tr in the 6th ch from hook, chl, sk next ch, *(1tr in the next ch, ch1, sk next ch) 12 times, ( 1 tr, chl, 1 tr) in the next ch, chl, sk next ch, (1tr in the next ch, chl, sk next ch) 18 times, ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in the next ch, chl, sk next ch, (1tr in the next ch, chl, sk next ch) 13 times, ( 1 tr, ch1, 1 tr) in the next ch, chl, sk next ch, (ltr in the next ch, ch1, sk next ch) 18 times, 1 tr in the same ch as the starting ch, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn. (66 lchsps, 4 raglan corners) NOTE: Place a stitch marker in each raglan corner.
Round 2: Ch4, (count as tr, ch1), *(1tr in the next 1 chsp, ch1), rep to next raglan corner, (1tr, chl, 1 tr ) in raglan corner*, rep from * all around, end rep with 1 tr in the starting raglan corner, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn. ( 701 chsps, 4 raglan

## corners)

Round 3-20: Rep prev round. (142
lchsps, 4 lchsp corners)
Size small, rep round 2 another 2 times. (150 1chsps, 4 1chsp corners)
Size medium, rep round 2 another 4 times. (158 lchsps, 4 lchsp corners)
Size large, rep round 2 another 6 times. (166 1chsps, 41chsp corners)

FIRST 3 SIZES ONLY: Next round: Ch6 (count as tr, ch3) sk the sleeve sts, 1 tr in the next raglan corner (sleeve opening created) (ch1, 1 tr in the next 1chsp) rep to next raglan corner, ch1, 1 tr in the next raglan corner, ch3, sk the sleeve sts, 1 tr in the next raglan corner, (second sleeve opening created) (chl, 1 tr in the next lchsp) rep to the next raglan corner, ch1, 1 slst in the 3rd ch, turn. $(78(82,86)$ chsps)

LARGE ONLY: Next round: Ch8 (count as tr, ch5) sk the sleeve sts, 1 tr in the next raglan corner (sleeve opening created) (chl, 1 tr in the next 1chsp) rep to next raglan corner, ch1, 1 tr in the next raglan corner, ch5, sk the sleeve sts, 1 tr in the next raglan corner, (second sleeve opening created) (ch1, 1 tr in the next 1chsp) rep to the next raglan corner, ch1, 1slst in the 3rd ch, turn. ( 90 chsps )

FIRST 3 SIZES ONLY: Next round: SIst to the 2nd ch, ch4 (count as tr, ch1) 1tr in the next tr, (ch1, 1 tr in the next lchsp), rep to last 1 chsp before the underarm-ch3, ch1, 1 tr in the next tr, chl, 1 tr in the 2nd ch, ch1, 1 tr in the next tr, (ch), 1 tr in the next lchsp) rep to the last 1 chsp before the underarm-ch3, ch1, 1 tr in the next tr, ch1, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn. (84 (88, 92) chsps)

LARGE ONLY: Next round: Slst to the 2nd ch, ch4 (count as tr, chl), sk next ch, 1 tr in the next ch, chl, 1 tr in the next tr, (chl, 1 tr in the next 1 chsp ), rep to last 1 chsp before the underarm-ch5, ch1, 1 tr in the next tr, (sk next ch, chl, 1tr in the next ch) twice, chl, 1 tr in the next tr, (ch1, 1tr in the next 1chsp) rep to the last 1 chsp before the underarm-ch5, ch1, 1 tr in the next tr, chl, sk next ch, 1 tr in the next ch, chl, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn. (98 chsps)

BODY:
Next round: Ch4 (count as tr, chl), (1tr in the next lchsp, chl), rep all around, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn.
Next 5 rounds: (small medium, large, see note at end of this row before continuing) Ch5 (count as tr, ch2), (1tr in the next lchsp, ch2), rep all around, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn.

## INCREASE DURING THE LAST ROUND ONLY: SMALL, MEDIUM, LARGE ONLY: SMALL:

Mark 2 equally spaced chsps with a stitch marker. Work ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in those chsps. (90 chsps)
MEDIUM \& LARGE: Mark 4 equally spaced chsps with a stitch marker. Work (1tr, ch1, 1 tr) in those chsps. (96 (102) chsps)
NOTE: The lchsps in the last round MUST
be divisible through 6 or the motifs won't fit in.

## MOTIFS:

Each motif is joined with dc's to the body during the last round.
Ch4, close with a slst OR make a magic circle.
Round 1: Ch3, 11 tr in ring, close with a slst.
Round 2: Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), *1 tr in next st, ch1*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch.
Round 3: Ch3, 2 tr in next 1 chsp, ${ }^{*} 1$ tr in next tr, 2tr in next 1chsp*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch.
Round 4: Chl, 1 htr in the same sp, ch3, sk next 2 sts, *1htr in next st, ch3, sk next 2 sts*, rep from * all around, close with chl, 1 htr in the starting htr.
Round 5: Joining round first motif: Ch1,
ldc around the htr of the prev round, ch2, work 1 dc in any of the 2 chsps of the body, ch2, 1dc in the 3chsp of the motif, (ch2, sk 1 2chsp of the body, 1dc in the next 2chsp of the body, ch2, 1dc in the 3chsp of the motif) twice, *ch4, 1dc in the next 3chsp of the motif*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the first dc. Fasten off.
Round 5: Joining subsequent motifs: Join the motifs in exactly the same manner as the first motif BUT the first join will take place on the left side of the prev motif. There will be three 4chsps on the left side, join in the bottom one first, then the next two spaces, then join to the body. Make sure when joining the motifs to the body that there is one unworked 2chsp be-
tween each join.
Continue joining motifs until the entire bottom edge of the body is filled with motifs.

Next Round: Join yarn in the 2chsp on the left of any of the motifs, ch6 (count as tr, ch3), ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 4chsp, ch3, ( 1 tr, ch3, 1 tr ) in the next 4chsp, ch3, 1 tr in the next 4chsp, ch3, (1tr in the next 2chsp, ch3) twice*, rep from * all around, close with a ch1, 1 htr in the 3rd ch, turn.
Next round: Ch6, (count as tr, ch3), *1tr in the next 3chsp, ch3*, rep from * all around, close with a chl, 1htr in the 3rd ch, turn.
Next round (small \& large see note at the end of this row): Rep prev round another 18 times.
INCREASE DURING THE LAST ROUND ONLY: SMALL, LARGE ONLY: Mark 2 equally spaced chsps with a stitch marker. Work ( 1 tr , ch1, 1 tr ) in those chsps. (92 (104) chsps)
NOTE: The 1 chsps in the last round MUST be divisible through 4 or the lace border won't fit in.

## LACE BORDER

(do not turn after each round)
Round 1: Ch3, 1tr in the same 3chsp, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 3chsp, ch3, sk next 3chsp, 1 tr in next tr, ch3, sk next 3chsp, *[(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next 3chsp] twice, ch3, sk next 3chsp, 1 tr in next tr, ch3, sk next 3chsp*, rep from * all around, work 2 tr in the starting 3chsp, close with a htr in the 3rd ch.
Round 2: Ch3, 1 tr around the post of the htr from the prev round, ch3, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next shell, ch2, 1 tr in the next tr, ch2, * $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{r}$ ) in the next shell, ch3, (2tr, ch2, 2 tr ) in the next shell, ch2, 1 tr in the next tr, ch2*, rep from * all around, work 2 tr in the starting shell, close with a htr in the 3rd ch.
Round 3: Ch3, 1 tr around the post of the htr of the prev round, ch1, 1 tr in the next 3chsp, ch1, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next shell, ch3 * 2 tr, ch2, 2 tr ) in the next shell, ch1, 1 tr in the next 3chsp, ch1, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next shell, ch3*, rep from * all around, work 2tr in the starting shell, close with a htr in the 3rd ch.
Round 4: Ch3, 1 tr around the post of the htr of the prev round, ch1, ( 1 tr, ch1, 1 tr) in the next tr, ch1, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next shell, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next shell, ch1, ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in the next tr, ch1, (2tr, ch2, 2 tr ) in the next shell*, rep from * all around, work 2tr in the starting shell, close with a htr in the 3rd ch.
Round 5: Ch3, 1 tr around the post of the htr of the prev round, ch2, 2 tr in the next tr, ch2, 2tr in the next tr, ch2, 2tr in the next
shell, ch1, *2tr in the next shell, ch2, 2tr in the next tr, ch2, 2tr in the next tr, ch2, 2tr in the next shell, chl*, rep from * all around, omit the last chl from the rep and close with a dc in the 3rd ch.
Round 6: Ch3, 1 tr around the post of the dc of the prev round, ch2, 1tr in next tr, 2 tr in next tr, ch5, 2 tr in next tr, 1 tr in next tr, ch2, *2tr between the next two 2tr-groupings, ch2, 1tr in next tr, 2 tr in next tr, ch5, 2 tr in next tr, 1 tr in next tr, ch2*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch. Round 7: SIst to between the first and second tr, ch5 (count as tr, ch2), 1tr in the next 2 tr , 2 tr in the next tr, ch2, 1 tr in the next 5chsp, ch2, 2 tr in the next tr, 1 tr in the next 2 tr , ch2, ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ between the next 2 tr , ch2, 1 tr in the next 2 tr , 2 tr in the next tr, ch2, 1 tr in the next 5 chsp, ch2, 2tr in the next tr, 1 tr in the next 2 tr , ch2*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch. Round 8: Slst to the next tr, ch3, 1 tr in the next 3 tr, ch2, ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in the next tr, ch2, 1 tr in the next $4 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 4,{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next $4 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in the next tr, ch2, 1 tr in the next 4 tr, ch4*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch.
Round 9: Ch3, 1 tr in the next 2 tr , ch3, 2tr in the next tr, ch2, 2tr in the next tr, ch3, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next $3 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3,{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 3 tr , ch3, 2 tr in the next tr, ch2, 2 tr in the next tr, ch3, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next 3 tr, ch3*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch.
Round 10: Ch3, 1 tr in the next tr, ch3, 1 tr in the next tr, 2 tr in the next tr, ch5, 2tr in the next tr, 1 tr in the next tr, ch3, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 2,{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 2 tr , ch3, 1 tr in the next tr, 2 tr in the next tr, ch5, 2 tr in the next tr, 1 tr in the next tr, ch3, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 2^{*}$, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch.
Round 11: SIst to between the first and second tr, ch6, (count as tr, ch3), 1 tr in the next 2 tr , 2 tr in the next tr, ch2, 1 tr in the next 5chsp, ch2, 2 tr in the next tr, 1 tr in the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3,1 \mathrm{tr}$ between the next 2 tr, ch1, *1tr between the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3,1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 2 tr , 2 tr in the next tr, ch2, 1 tr in the next 5chsp, ch2, 2 tr in the next tr, 1tr in the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3,1 \mathrm{tr}$ between the next 2 tr, chl*, rep from * all around, close with a dc in the 3rd ch.
Round 12: Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), 1tr in the next 4 tr, ch3, (1tr, ch1, 1 tr) in the next tr, ch3, 1 tr in the next $4 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1,{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ between the next 2 tr , chl, 1 tr in the next $4 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3$, ( 1 tr , ch1, 1 tr ) in the next tr, ch3, 1 tr in the next $4 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1^{*}$, rep from * rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch.
Round 13: SIst across the next ch to the next tr, ch3, 1 tr in the next 2 tr , ch4, (1tr, ch2, 1 tr) in the next 1chsp, ch4, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next $3 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 5,{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 3 tr , ch4, ( $1 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 2,1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in the next 1 chsp, ch4, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next 3 tr, ch5*, rep from

* all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch. Round 14: Ch3, 1 tr in the next tr, ch4, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in the next 2chsp, ch4, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3,{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in the next 2 tr , ch4, ( 2 tr, ch3, 2tr) in the next 2chsp, ch4, sk next tr, 1 tr in the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3^{*}$, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch. Round 15: Slst to between the first and second tr, ch7 (count as tr, ch4), (2tr, ch1, $2 t r$, chl, 2 tr ) in the next 2chsp, ch4, sk next tr, 1 tr between the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1,{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{tr}$ between the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 4$, (2tr, chl, 2tr, chl, $2 t r$ ) in the next 2chsp, ch4, 1 tr between the next 2 tr , ch1*, rep from * all around, close with a dc in the 3rd ch.
Round 16: Ch8 (count as tr, ch5), (2tr, ch2, 2 tr ) in the next 1 chsp, ch2, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next 1chsp, ch5, *1tr between the next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 5$, $(2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{rr})$ in the next 1chsp, ch2, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in the next lchsp, ch5*, rep from * all around, close with a slst in the 3rd ch. Fasten off.


## SLEEVES:

Round 1: With RS facing, join yarn in the left 1 chsp, ch4 (count as tr, ch1) 1 tr around the post of the next tr, ch1, 1tr in the raglan corner-space, ch1, *1tr in the next 1 chsp, ch1*, rep all around the sleeve opening to the next raglan corner-space, 1 tr in the next raglan corner-space, chl, 1 tr around the post of the next tr, ch1, 1 tr in the last $1(1,1,2)$ $1 \mathrm{chsp} / \mathrm{s}$ under the arm, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn.
Round 2: Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), *1tr in the next 1 chsp, ch1*, rep from * all around, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn
Round 3-12: Ch5 (count as tr, ch2), *1tr in next 2chsp, ch2*, rep from * all around, close with a dc in the 3rd ch, turn
Round 13: Work the round as the previous round BUT, INCREASE DURING THIS ROUND ONLY: EXTRA-SMALL \& MEDIUM: Mark one lchsp with a stitch marker. Work (1tr, ch1, 1 tr) in that chsp. ( 40 (44) chsps)
SMALL \& LARGE: mark three lchsps with a stitch marker. Work ( 1 tr, ch 1, 1 tr) in that chsp. (44 (48) chsps)
Round 14-26: Ch6 (count as tr, ch3), *1tr in next 2chsp, ch3*, rep from * all around, close with a htr in the 3rd ch, turn.
NOTE: The lchsps in the last round MUST be divisible through 4 or the lace border won't fit in. If for some reason it doesn't, adjust during the last round as was done on the body.
Round 27 onwards: Rep row 1 - 16 of the lace border. Fasten off.

NECK EDGING:
Work 1 round of dc. Fasten off.

## FINISH UP:

Weave in all loose ends. Block according to measurements given.

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
