



ORIGINAL GARMENT: One size fits all.

MATERIALS:

2 Hanks **EXPRESS YOURSELF INSPIRE** 100g

10mm Crochet hook

TENSION:

6tr x 6 rows = 10 x 10cm.

MEASUREMENTS:

From brim to point = 27cm.

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch – chain

blo – back loop only

dc – double crochet

rem – remian(ing)

rnd(s) - round(es)

RS – right side

sk – skip

sl st – slip stitch

st – stitch

tr – treble

NOTE:

The beanie is worked from front to back.
The brim is added last.

PATTERN:

With 10mm crochet hook, make 38ch, sl st into first ch to form a ring.

1st Rnd: 3ch (= tr), work tr in each ch across, close with a sl st in 3rd ch and turn (= 38tr).

2nd Rnd: Sl st to between the 1st and 2nd tr and 3ch (= tr), work tr between each and every tr around, close with sl st in 3rd ch, turn.

3rd - 14th Rnd: Rep 2nd rnd.
Fasten off but leave a long tail.

BRIM RIBBING:

Insert hook in any ch of the rem foundation ch loops and fasten with a sl st.

1st Row: 5ch, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook and work dc in each ch across, sl st into beg foundation ch and next 2ch, turn = 4dc and 3 sl sts.

2nd Row: Sk the next 3sl sts of the prev row, work dc in next 4dc but blo, turn.

3rd Row: Ch (= not 1st st), dc in blo in next 4dc, sl st in beg foundation ch and next 2ch, turn.

Rep 2nd & 3rd row across the entire brim.
Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP:

Sew the ribbing close and weave in all loose ends. Take the long tail of the end of the hat and weave it through every alternative st.

Pull close and weave in loose ends.
