



ORIGINAL GARMENT: One size fits all.

### MATERIALS:

1 Hank **EXPRESS YOURSELF INSPIRE** 100g

8mm Knitting needles  
10mm Knitting needles  
8mm Crochet hook

### TENSION:

10sts x 15 rows = 10cm using 10 mm needles over stocking stitch.

### MEASUREMENTS:

One size fits all.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**beg** - begin(ing)

**inc** - increase

**k** - knit

**k2tog** - knit 2sts together

**p** - purl

**patt** - pattern

**rep** - repeat

**skpsso** - slip1, k1, pass slipped stitch over

**sl st** - slip stitch

**st(s)** - stitch(es)

**yfwd** - yarn to the front of needle

### NOTE:

Always slip the first stitch of every row and pull the yarn tightly to keep the edges of the scarf neat and even.

### STITCHES USED:

#### Double rib:

**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** (K2, p2) rep to end.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Row:** (P2, k2) rep to end.

### PATTERN:

Using 8mm knitting needles, cast on 16sts.  
Work in **double rib** until work measures 16cm. Inc 5sts evenly on the last row.  
Change to 10mm needles and work in patt as follows.

**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** Sl1, k1, \*(yfwd, k2tog) rep from \* to last st, k1.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Row:** Sl1, p to last st, k1.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Row:** K1, \*(skpsso, yfwd) rep from \* to last 2sts, k2.

**4<sup>th</sup> Row:** Sl1, p to last st, k1.

Work this patt until work measures 75cm from beg of patt, or to desired length, ending with a 4<sup>th</sup> row to complete the patt. Cast off.

Fold the rib section in half and sl st neatly to the 1<sup>st</sup> patt row to form the loop.  
Sew in loose threads.
